Enameling on Metal

Enameling--glass fused to metal at high heat – combines the qualities of glass, metal, and fire. This workshop introduces preparation of metal and basic enameling techniques - - sifting, use of various adhesives, sgraffito, painting, and stencil – for applying powdered glass to metal. After a few minutes of firing at 1500 degrees, more layers of opaque and translucent glass are added; the process repeats many times. Participants will produce numerous small trial pieces, a finished enameled copper tile, and a pendant. The class includes a brief overview of enameling in various cultures, along with a sampling of some contemporary work in enameling. Bring several pictures or drawings of images you would like to create in enamels. All class materials are provided.
